- ❑ **Pencil Pouch** with 3-holes for Trapper Keeper
- ❑ **Earbuds/Headphones** - We recommend a comfortable pair of headphones that the teacher will keep safe in the classroom.
- ❑ **Pencils**- any style your child likes to use.
- ❑ **Tissues**
- ❑ **Classroom Community** - Supplies are provided for the year through a **\$50.00** per student supply fee. You can pay with a credit card on your child's Emergency Card form or send a check to the school's front office.
